MINUTES OF THE SENATE FEDERAL AND STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

Chairperson Brungardt thanked the committee and explained that the reason for sending <u>SB 305</u> back to committee was to clean-up the language in the bill dealing with taxes on liquor. He explained that the bill was now a bill to create uniformity among Kansas liquor laws.

Chairperson Brungardt asked for a motion to reverse the motion made by Senator Clark earlier in the day to table **SB 305**. He explained that it would require a two-thirds majority to reverse the motion.

<u>Senator Clark made a motion to reverse his motion from earlier in the day. The motion was seconded by Senator O' Connor. The motion to reverse the motion to table **SB 305** passed.</u>

Theresa Kiernan explained to the committee that amendments would have to be made to the bill to remove language pertaining to tax. She explained that page 12, lines 4-6 must be cleaned-up and page 1 lines 12-14 must also be cleaned-up.

Senator Clark made a motion to amend **SB 305** according to Ms. Kiernan's specifications. The motion was seconded by Senator O' Connor. The motion to amend **SB 305** passed.

Chairperson Brungardt asked for a motion to pass the bill out of committee.

Senator Clark made a motion to recommend **SB 305** favorable for passage as amended. The motion was seconded by Senator O' Connor. The motion to recommend **SB 305** favorable for passage passed.

Chairperson Brungardt thanked the committee.
