Senator Tyson called the meeting to order.

Further discussion on <u>SB 496</u> <u>SB 496 is concerning hunting; relating to the revocation or suspension of hunting licenses;</u> <u>amending K.S.A. 32-1013 and repealing the existing section.</u>

The Committee had a discussion and made changes to the Substitute for <u>SB 496.</u> Several points were discussed such as including the wording, not wounded in relation to hunting violator. Community service was discussed for hunting violations in lieu of jail time for the first time offenders.

In proposed Substitute for <u>SB 496</u>, the word trapping was struck and replaced with fur harvesting as one of the main changes made by the Committee. Lisa Montgomery, Staff, will draw up the changes to the bill. <u>A motion was made by Senator Taddiken to adopt a balloon for Substitute for SB496</u>. Senator Lee seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motioned passed. Technical changes were made to the bill. <u>Senator Schmidt made the motion to pass the bill out favorably</u>. Senator Taddiken seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motion passed.
