<u>Discussion and Action on HCR 5016 - Concurrent Resolution supporting a Taiwan-United States trade</u> agreement

Chairman Johnson opened the floor for discussion on <u>HCR 5016</u>, a concurrent resolution supporting a Taiwan-United States trade agreement.

Representative Larkin moved to amend HCR 5016 to add language encouraging Taiwan to lift the ban on the importation of U.S. beef and beef products. (Attachment 1) In addition, Representative Larkin requested that the amended language be reflected in the title of the resolution. Seconded by Representative Feuerborn, the motion carried.
