Chairperson Freeborn announced they would not be working <u>HB 2014 - Powers of members ex officio of</u> <u>the Kansas Water Authority</u> today, but will take action on that at another time. She reminded people to sign the guest list. There will be a presentation by the Kansas Water Office on the purchase of water storage in federal reservoirs, and a hearing on <u>HB 2393 - Controlling the release of water from Cedar Bluff</u> <u>Reservoir</u> next Tuesday, February 15.
