Chairman Johnson opened the hearing on $\underline{SB 332}$ - Authorizing regents' institutions to acquire insurance. Theresa Klinkenberg, the Chief Business and Financial Planning Officer at the University of Kansas, was welcomed to the committee to testify as a proponent to $\underline{SB 332}$.
