Chairman Umbarger called the committee's attention to discussion of:

<u>Senate Substitute for HB 2518--Death benefits for beneficiaries of certain Kansas national guard members; appropriations therefor (Attachment 1)</u>

Gordon Self, Revisor of Statutes Office, explained the possible tax implications of federal and state taxes regarding the death benefit proposed in the bill. The Committee discussed the proposed substitute bill. Senator Barone moved, with a second by Senator Emler, to insert language in Senate Substitute for HB 2518 similar to KPERS to insure that the death benefit is not taxed at the state level. Motion carried on a voice vote.

Senator Wysong moved, with a second by Senator Teichman, to recommend **Senate Substitute for HB 2518** favorable for passage as amended. Motion carried on a roll call vote. (Attachment 2)

Senator Barone asked the committee to review a draft bill concerning the Kansas National Guard, providing for reimbursement of premium costs of certain death benefits for members in federal service; prescribing certain duties and functions for the Adjutant General; making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, for the Adjutant General. No action was taken.
