Discussion and Action on SB 232 - Municipalities; postemployment benefits other than retirement; authorization.

<u>Representative Flaharty moved to recommend **SB 232** favorably for passage. The motion was seconded by Representative Gordon. Motion carried on voice vote.</u>

Discussion and Action on SB 362 - Enacting the Kansas Public Employees Retirement System Act of 2009.

Representative Gordon moved to recommend **SB 362** favorably for passage. The motion was seconded by Representative Long. Motion carried on voice vote.

Julian Efird, Legislative Research Department, explained that <u>SB 362</u> contains the same language as <u>HB 2588</u>, a bill passed out of Committee and moved to the House floor on March 8, 2007.
