Hearing on SB 188 - Commercialization of wildlife

The Chairman opened the hearing on **SB 188** - wildlife restoration fund.

Chris Tymeson, Chief Legal Counsel, Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks (KDWP), stated that <u>SB 188</u> is a departmental initiative designed to increase restitution money for illegal commercialization of wildlife (<u>Attachment 1</u>). He said the threshold for felony and misdemeanor crimes was raised during the 2006 legislative session; wildlife values, however, were not increased correspondingly. Mr. Tymeson requested the members consider increasing wildlife values as recommended by KDWP.

The Chairman closed the hearing on **SB 188**.

The Chairman called for consideration <u>SB 19</u> - county fairs levy for buildings, grounds and maintenance. Representative Svaty moved to pass <u>SB 19</u> favorably and place it on the Consent Calendar. Representative Powell seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The Chairman announced a brief meeting of sub-committee members following adjournment for discussion of **SB 249**.
