Risk-based Capital

Changing date in item (j) to December 31, 2007.

KSA 40-2252 Clean Up

KSA 40-2251 changed last year from KDHE to Health Policy Authority, KSA 40-2252 goes along with that but was not changed.

Eliminate "seal of corporation" requirement [KSA 40-218]

Incoming companies will no longer be required to create a seal and use it on forms

Electronic Signature [KSA 40-1702, 40-3213, 75-1508, 40-252]

Eliminates need for manual signatures and paper forms allowing for electronic filing and signature exclusively

Premium Tax for group-funded workers comp pools changed to "actual" premium [KSA 44-581] Currently the tax is collected on estimated premium; this would have it collected on the actual premium collected.

Updating definition of "financial institution" [KSA 40-229a]

Changes the definition of financial institution to comply with NAIC standards

HMO merger standardization [KSA 40-309]

Companies would now be required to follow merger requirements for HMO's

Grants commissioner ability to adopt rules and regs that protect military personnel on Kansas Military Installations

Smith, Kansas Department of Credit Unions, (<u>Attachment #3 and Attachment #4</u>), requested bill introductions to provide technical corrections for consistency between KSA 17-2242 and KSA 17-2204a. <u>Representative Brown moved for the introduction of the bills.</u> <u>Seconded by Representative Neighbor. Motion carried.</u>

Representative Dillmore moved for a bill introduction establishing a pilot program to allow certain small businesses to provide health insurance through the State Employees Health Benefits Program. Seconded by Representative Oletha Faust-Goudeau. Motion carried.
