The Committee met at 12:30 p.m., March 12, 2008 to start the tour of Old Castle Precast, Inc., at 5230 NW 17th Street, Topeka, KS. It was a very informative tour - the members learned the concrete pipe industry is a significant economic sector in the State of Kansas in terms of output, employment, income, and taxes paid. According to Mark Chinery, President, Concrete Pipe Resources, Inc., the total impact of the concrete pipe industry is approximately \$79.1 million to the state's economy and 446 jobs.

Committee members toured the plant, wearing safety hats, and vests. They observed the concrete from the sand and gravel stage to formed pipes and prison cells. Members learned that only concrete pipe has a proven service life of over 100 years and that throughout the country, there are concrete pipe sanitary and combined sewers that were installed in the 1860's and are still in use today.
