Paul Snider, Kansas City Power & Light announced the release of information about a collaborative agreement with Sierra Club, Kansas City Power & Light and concerned citizens of Platte County to reduce emissions and spur clean energy development. (Attachment 1)

Chairman Emler opened for committee discussion and possible action on: **HB 2127** - Electric generation facilities, parallel generation contracts.

Senator Taddiken, Chairman of the Senate Agriculture Committee, reported the Ag Committee had taken action on **HB 2145** by rolling **HB 2127** into **HB 2145** and passed **HB 2145** out favorably as amended. He noted **HB 2145** as amended would provide for a pilot project for Cloud County Community College and funding of \$50,000 per year for 14 years from the Pump Control Inspection Fee fund. Dodge City Community College also wanted to be eligible. Due to the action taken by the Senate Ag Committee, the Senate Utilities Committee did not take any action on **HB 2127**.
