Chairman Yoder welcomed Committee members and guests and noted that today is Kansas Day. The Committee will meet tomorrow and begin work on <u>HB 2022.</u>

Chairman Yoder responded to questions from Committee members regarding the procedures involved with working bills and the time frame involved.

Chairman presented information on House Appropriations Committee Rules (<u>Attachment 1</u>) and House Appropriations Notice to Conferees (<u>Attachment 2</u>).

Alan Conroy, Kansas Legislative Research Department, presented an overview of the Comparison of FY 2009 Budget Adjustments (<u>Attachment 3</u>). Adjustments based on the Governor's recommendations total \$200.4 million. The Senate Ways and Means Committee adjustments total \$301.7 million. The Senate tentative adjustments total \$334.8 million.

Alan Conroy responded to questions from Committee members regarding the transfer balances and budget adjustments and the impact on clients. The Governor's proposal represents a 3 percent cut to programs except for legislative, judicial, K-12 and social service caseloads. The Senate's proposal is a 1.5 percent cut to programs except K-12.
