MINUTES OF THE SENATE FEDERAL AND STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

HB 2099 - Withdrawal of guilty plea, time limitation.

Chairman Brungardt opened the hearing on HB 2099.

Jason Thompson, office of the revisor of statutes staff, provided the committee with the proposed substitute bill. (Attachment 1) Staff stated that the contents of the bill dealing with withdrawal of a guilty plea have already been moved to **HB 2233** logged and signed by the Governor. The proposal would be to strike the contents and insert the substitute bill, which contains the contents of two prior bills. The substitute bill is in three sections: Section 1, sub section (w) page 17, deals with records and reports from the parole board in closed session; the companion piece located on page 34; Section 3, starting with sub section 16 deals with confidentiality, closed or executive meeting and penalties. Section 2 in the middle is repealing the law of **SB 87** and **HB 2052** and changing the word on page 29 from crime after "alleged victims of" to *stalking*.

Senator Owens moved to strike the contents of **HB 2099**, and insert the proposed substitute language. Senator Reitz seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Senator Francisco moved to strike the contents of Section 1 and Section 3. Senator Reitz seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Senator Reitz moved to pass **HB 2099** favorably as a substitute bill. Senator Owens seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Chairman Brungardt closed the hearing on **HB 2099**.
