Presentation on Federal Stimulus Package, Energy and Rate Making

Joe Harkins, Commissioner, Kansas Corporation Commission, outlined the goals and strategies focused on by KCC in the economic stimulus energy efficiency initiatives being funneled into Kansas through the KCC. There are three goals: (1) reduce energy consumption (electricity and natural gas); (2) reduce emissions of carbon dioxide and other pollutants; and (3) stimulate local economies. Strategies are (1) expand existing and develop additional comprehensive programs to increase energy conservation and efficiency in buildings for all classes of utility customers; and (2) encourage development of dynamic pricing.
