Discussion and Action on HB 2666 - Animal health department; fees

Chairman Emler explained that <u>SB 571</u> and <u>HB 2666</u> are identical bills except for an amendment to <u>SB 571</u>.

<u>SB 571</u> was worked by the Senate Ways and Means Committee, amended by changing the effective date of the legislation from "publication in statute book" to "publication in the register", recommended for favorable passage by the Committee and passed favorably on the Senate floor. The bill was then referred to the House Agriculture and Natural Resources Committee.

<u>HB 2666</u> was worked by the House Agriculture and Natural Resources Committee, recommended for favorable passage and passed favorably on the House floor. The bill was then referred to the Senate Ways and Means Committee.

Because <u>SB 571</u> was referred to a non-exempt committee, the Chairman requested that the Committee address <u>HB 2666</u>.

Senator Teichman moved to amend **HB 2666** by changing the effective date from "publication in the statute book" to "publication in the register". The motion was seconded by Senator Kelly. Motion carried on a voice vote.

Senator Lee moved to recommend **HB 2666** as amended for favorable passage. The motion was seconded by Senator Vratil. Motion carried on a voice vote.
