Representative Tom Sloan made a motion to introduce a bill concerning public water supply systems; concerning regulation and related fees; providing exemptions from certain fees and taxes. Representative Henry Helgerson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

She announced that personnel from the Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks, Secretary Steve Williams; Clint Riley, Department Attorney; and Rob Manes of the Pratt, Kansas office are in attendance today and will meet with committee members after the committee meeting to discuss deer issues.
