Hearing on:

<u>HCR 5070</u> - <u>urging the Department of Agriculture, Department of Commerce, Kansas State</u> <u>Research and Extension of the College of Agriculture, Kansas Cattlemen's Association,</u> <u>Kansas Farm Bureau, Kansas Farmers Union, Kansas Pork Producers Council, Kansas</u> <u>Livestock Association and the independent small locker plants to assist producers of beef,</u> <u>pork and poultry to market their own products.</u>

Representative Daniel Thimesch appeared before the committee to support <u>HCR 5070</u> as an important means of encouragement to producers of beef, pork and poultry to market their own products.
