Senator Umbarger made a motion to approve the minutes of the January 12, 2000 meeting as submitted. Senator Biggs seconded. Motion carried.

Greg Krissek, Assistant Secretary, Department of Agriculture, requested introduction of a bill that would make technical amendments to the Kansas Egg Law (<u>Attachment 1</u>). The most significant change would be to decrease from 60 to 45 degrees the temperature at which eggs intended for human consumption may be held in storage. These changes are prompted by a change at the Federal level.

Senator Umbarger made a motion to introduce the bill. Senator Biggs seconded. The motion carried.

Greg Krissek, Assistant Secretary, Department of Agriculture, requested introduction of a bill to revamp and modernize the Kansas Noxious Weed Law. The modifications would include a biologically based noxious weed classification scheme, subsidized control and enforcement (<u>Attachment 2</u>).

Senator Corbin made a motion to introduce the bill. Senator Umbarger seconded. The motion carried.
