MINUTES OF THE SENATE FEDERAL AND STATE AFFAIRS.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Senator Lana Oleen at 9:20 a.m. on January 21, 2000 on the third floor at the rail of the Capitol.

Chairman Oleen recognized Adj. General Gerald Gardner who requested the introduction of a bill.

Adj. General Gardner requested that a bill be introduced that would allow the governor to execute a compact on behalf of the state of Kansas to enter into a compact with other states to provide mutual assistance in managing any emergency or disaster. <u>Senator Vidricksen moved to introduce the bill</u>. <u>Senator Becker</u> <u>seconded the motion, The motion carried</u>.

Chairman Oleen announced the continued discussion of **SB 393-K-GOAL** to address the questions raised about the language and the effective date of the bill. Senator Jones stated that he did have a concern with the language contained in the bill with reference to employees and would like to see the language returned to the current law. Senator Oleen stated that to insure that the K-GOAL audits were not interrupted, the effective date be change to publication in the Register. <u>Senator Jones moved to amend **SB 393** to return to the original language and to make the effective date the Register. Senator Becker seconded the motion. The motion carried. Senator Gooch moved to report the bill favorable to the whole senate; Senator Vidricksen seconded the motion. The motion carried.</u>
