<u>SB 426</u>: <u>Relating to apportioned fleet registration; permanent registration of utility trailers</u>

Sheila Walker, Director, Division of Vehicles, Department of Revenue requested introduction of this bill and appeared in support of changing the five-year registration period for fleet utility trailers; i.e., rental trailers, to a permanent registration. She explained that payment of an annual registration fee would still be required. This would be a time and money saving move for the Division.

SB 497: Relating to motor vehicles; temporary intrastate registration - trucks

Ms. Walker also requested this bill and explained the purpose of <u>SB 497</u> is to bring Kansas into compliance with the International Registration Plan (IRP) (<u>Attachment 1</u>).

No one appeared in opposition to either bill. Following committee discussion, <u>Senator Jordan moved to</u> recommend **SB 426** and **SB 427** be passed. Senator Salmans seconded the motion. Motion carried. Senator Vidricksen will carry both bills.
