2014 Kansas Statutes

18-144a. Boundary between Jefferson and Shawnee. That the boundary line dividing and separating the counties of Shawnee and Jefferson, state of Kansas, shall hereafter be as follows: Commencing at the southeast corner of the northeast quarter of section 26, township 11, range 16, east of the sixth principal meridian; thence west, to the center of the Kansas river; thence northerly along the center of said Kansas river, to the south line of the northeast quarter of section 23, township 11, range 16, east of the sixth principal meridian; thence east, to the east line of section 23, township 11, range 16, east of the sixth principal meridian; thence east, to the east Shawnee and Jefferson counties as now constituted.
