2014 Kansas Statutes

21-5104. Severability; invalidity of part of code. The provisions of the Kansas criminal code are severable. If any provision of this code or any part thereof and any amendment thereto is held invalid or unconstitutional or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, it shall be conclusively presumed that the legislature would have enacted the remainder of the code without such invalid or unconstitutional provision. **History:** L. 2010, ch. 136, § 4; July 1, 2011.
