

REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Committee on **Corrections and Juvenile Justice** recommends **HB 2055**, as amended by House Committee of the Whole, be amended on page 1, following line 4, by inserting:

"WHEREAS, The provisions of K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 21-6811(c), as amended by this act, shall be known and may be cited as Mija Stockman's Law; Now, therefore,

On page 2, in line 3, by striking "An" and inserting "Any"; also in line 3, after "K.S.A." by inserting "8-2,144 or"; also in line 3, after "8-1567" by inserting "or K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 8-1025"; in line 5, by striking "the" and inserting "any"; also in line 5, after "K.S.A." by inserting "8-2,144 or"; also in line 5, after "8-1567" by inserting "or K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 8-1025"; following line 7, by inserting:

"(3) If the current crime of conviction is for a violation of K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 21-5413(b)(3), and amendments thereto:

(A) The first prior adult conviction, diversion in lieu of criminal prosecution or juvenile adjudication for the following shall count as one nonperson felony for criminal history purposes:

(i) Any act described in K.S.A. 8-2,144 or 8-1567 or K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 8-1025, and amendments thereto; or (ii) a violation of a law of another state or an ordinance of any city, or resolution of any county, which prohibits any act described in K.S.A. 8-2,144 or 8-1567 or K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 8-1025, and amendments thereto; and

(B) each second or subsequent prior adult conviction, diversion in lieu of criminal

prosecution or juvenile adjudication for the following shall count as one person felony for criminal history purposes: (i) Any act described in K.S.A. 8-2,144 or 8-1567 or K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 8-1025, and amendments thereto; or (ii) a violation of a law of another state or an ordinance of any city, or resolution of any county, which prohibits any act described in K.S.A. 8-2,144 or 8-1567 or K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 8-1025, and amendments thereto.";

On page 1, in the title, in line 2, after "history;" by inserting "aggravated battery, driving under the influence;"; and the bill be passed as amended.
