**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2442 by Legislative Post Audit Committee

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2442 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, written reports of information technology audits conducted by the Legislative Division of Post Audit must be furnished to the Governor, the audited agency, the chief information technology officers of the three branches of government, the Legislative Post Audit Committee and the Joint Committee on Information Technology. HB 2442 would remove the requirement to provide reports to the Governor and the chief information technology officers of all three branches of government. Reports would be provided to only the chief information technology officer of the branch of government to which the agency being audited belongs.

The Legislative Division of Post Audit indicates that enactment of HB 2442 would have no fiscal effect.
