SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2441 by Legislative Post Audit Committee

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2441 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, the Legislative Division of Post Audit is required to conduct three school district efficiency audits at the discretion of the Legislative Post Audit Committee. No school district is required to participate in an audit if the district has participated in a similar audit in the previous five years. HB 2441 would increase this limit from five years to ten years. In addition, the bill would extend the sunset date of this law's provisions from June 30, 2017, to June 30, 2020.

According to the Legislative Division of Post Audit, enactment of HB 2441 would have no fiscal effect.
