SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 482 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 482 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 482 would require a prosecuting attorney or judicial officer to petition the court for an expungement of the record upon dismissal of charges or declining to prosecute a person who was arrested due to mistaken identity or because another person used the identifying information of the arrestee. There would be no docket fee for an expungement action initiated by a prosecuting attorney or judicial officer. The bill would reorganize existing expungement statutes based on the new provisions and would define the term "mistaken identity."

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates SB 482 would have a negligible fiscal effect on Judicial Branch expenditures.
