1 AN ACT concerning public employment; relating to wage discrimination 2 on the basis of sex; study by secretary of administration. 3 4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:* 5 Section 1. (a) The secretary of administration is hereby authorized 6 and directed to: 7 (1) Make a study concerning whether any public employer having 8 employees of both sexes discriminates between employees on the basis of sex by paying wages to employees at a rate less that the rate of wages paid 9 to employees of the opposite sex for equal work, the performance of which 10 requires equal skill, effort and responsibility, and which are performed 11 12 under similar working conditions; 13 (2) develop recommendations and a plan to mitigate any such 14 discrimination; 15 (3) review statutory and rule and regulation changes necessary to 16 carry out such a plan; 17 (4) estimate any additional staff and positions required to implement 18 such a plan: 19 (5) identify any steps needed for interaction with the federal 20 government in ways that are reasonably designed to carry out the purposes 21 of this subsection: and 22 (6) review such other matters as may be necessary in making the 23 study. 24 (b) On or before January 11, 2016, the secretary of administration 25 shall submit to the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, each member of the committee on commerce of the senate 26 27 and each member of the committee on commerce, labor and economic 28 development of the house of representatives a report of the secretary's 29 findings and recommendations from the study conducted under subsection 30 (a). 31 (c) For purposes of this section, "public employer" means the state of 32 Kansas. "Public employee" means any employee of the state of Kansas. 33 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 34 publication in the statute book.
