1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to veterans distinctive plates;  
2 decals for certain military medals or badges; amending K.S.A. 2015  
3 Supp. 8-1,156 and repealing the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 8-1,156 is hereby amended to read as  
7 follows: 8-1,156. (a) Any person issued a license plate under the  
8 provisions of K.S.A. 8-161, 8-177c, 8-1,140 or 8-1,146 or K.S.A. 2015  
9 Supp. 8-1,163, and amendments thereto, upon submitting satisfactory  
10 proof to the director of vehicles in accordance with rules and regulations  
11 adopted by the secretary, that such person was awarded a silver star or  
12 bronze star medal by the United States government, may request a decal  
13 for each license plate indicating the person was a recipient of a silver star  
14 or bronze star medal.

15 (b) ~~On and after January 1, 2006,~~ Any person issued a license plate  
16 under the provisions of K.S.A. 8-161, 8-177c, 8-1,140 or 8-1,146 or  
17 K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 8-1,163, and amendments thereto, upon submitting  
18 satisfactory proof to the director of vehicles in accordance with rules and  
19 regulations adopted by the secretary, that such person was awarded a  
20 combat medical badge, army combat infantry badge, navy/marine corps  
21 combat action ribbon, army distinguished service cross, navy cross, air  
22 force cross or distinguished flying cross by the United States government,  
23 may request a decal for each license plate indicating the person was a  
24 recipient of a combat medical badge, army combat infantry badge,  
25 navy/marine corps combat action ribbon, army distinguished service cross,  
26 navy cross, air force cross or distinguished flying cross.

27 (c) A fee of \$2 shall be paid for each decal issued. The director of  
28 vehicles shall design such decals. Such decals shall be affixed to the  
29 license plate in the location required by the director. Not more than two  
30 decals authorized by this section shall be affixed to any one license plate.

31 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 8-1,156 is hereby repealed.

32 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
33 publication in the statute book.
