1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to commercial driver's  
2 licenses; hazardous materials endorsement exemption.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. Any person driving under a commercial class A license  
6 shall not be required to obtain a hazardous materials endorsement pursuant  
7 to 49 C.F.R. § 383 if the person is:

8 (a) Acting within the scope of the license holder's employment as an  
9 employee of a custom harvester operation, ~~agrichemical business, farm~~  
10 ~~retail outlet and supplier or livestock feeder~~; and

11 (b) is operating a service vehicle that is: (1) Transporting diesel in a  
12 quantity of 3,785 liters, 1,000 gallons or less; and (2) clearly marked with  
13 a "flammable" or "combustible" placard, as appropriate.

14 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
15 publication in the Kansas register.
