SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 5023

As Recommended by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

Brief*

HCR 5023 would state that Kansas claims sovereignty over all powers not otherwise enumerated and granted to the federal government by the *U.S. Constitution* under the 10th Amendment to the *U.S. Constitution*.

The resolution would specify:

- It would serve as notice to the federal government of the State's demand to maintain the balance of powers where the U.S. Constitution established it;
- The State intends to ensure that all government agencies and their agents and employees operating within Kansas' borders, or whose actions have an effect on the inhabitants, lands, or water of Kansas, will operate within the confines of the original intent of the U.S. Constitution;
- The Kansas Secretary of State would be required to send an enrolled copy of the resolution to the President of the United States, the President Pro Tempore of the U.S. Senate, the Speaker of the U.S. House of Representatives, and each member of the Kansas congressional delegation.
