Hearings on HB 2622 - Establishment of the Northeast Kansas Technology College were opened.

Representative Jerry Henry appeared before the committee as sponsor of the bill. He introduced Kenneth Clouse, Director of the Northeast Kansas Area Technical School (NEKATS) and Linda Henry, Coordinator of Special Programs, NEKATS, who appeared as a proponents of the bill. They explained that, since more and more students in Kansas desire to obtain a college degree in technical fields, the elevation of the Northeast Kansas Area Technical School to college status would enable them to offer current and future students a curriculum that more closely meets their needs. Hearings on HB 2622 were closed.

Representative John Ballou moved to place **HB 2622** on the Consent Calendar. Representative Morrison seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Hearings on HB 2655 - Kansas postsecondary educational savings program were opened.

State Treasurer Tim Shallenburger appeared before the committee as a proponent of **HB 2655**. Mr. Shallenburger handed out a list of proposed changes to the bill and explained each one. (Attachment 2) Mr. Shallenburger then introduced Bill Bates, Vice President-Governmental Affairs, American Century Investments. Mr. Bates presented testimony in favor of **HB 2655**. (Attachment 3)

Hearings on HB 2655 were closed.
