

2016 Kansas Statutes

72-6481. Severability. (a) The provisions of K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 72-6463 through 72-6481, and K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 72-6483 through 72-6485, and amendments thereto, shall be severable. If any provision of K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 72-6463 through 72-6481, and K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 72-6483 through 72-6485, and amendments thereto, or any application of such provision to any person or circumstance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by court order, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 72-6463 through 72-6481, and K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 72-6483 through 72-6485, and amendments thereto, which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application.

(b) The provisions of this section shall be effective from and after July 1, 2015, through June 30, 2017.
