Dear Ms. Reese:

I have looked into the situation regarding the money that was seized from you on August 25, 1995 by the Kansas Highway Patrol.

It appears that money was turned over to the federal government pursuant to some federal law and notice was given to you by the federal government by letter dated September 25, 1995 and received by you on October 2, 1995.

Thus, when I signed the order for the return of the money on January 17, 1996 the money was no longer in the custody of the Kansas Highway Patrol to be returned.

Your recourse is to seek the return of the money from the federal government through established procedures under federal law.

COURT ORDER

NOW on this 17 day of JANUARY, 1995⁶, comes on for hearing the defendant's motion for the return of property. The State of Kansas appears by and through Christopher L. Schneider, Assistant District Attorney. The defendant appears by and through her attorney, Jay H. Vader.

After hearing the arguments of counsel and being well and fully advised in the premises the Court sustains said motion.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THIS COURT ORDERED that the Highway Patrol or any other law enforcement agency that has possession of the currency siezed from the defendant as a result of her arrest on August 24, 1995, be returned to the defendant by and through her attorney, Jay H. Vader, immediately. The Court specifically finds that there is at least ~~\$15,200.00~~ ^{\$15,660.00} in cash that belongs to the defendant.
