## Re: <u>Kansas HB 2332, Relating to Disclosure of Electronic Communications and Electronically</u> <u>Stored Data</u>

Dear Chair DeGraaf and Members of the Committee:

The State Privacy and Security Coalition, a coalition of 25 leading communications, technology, retail, and media companies and six trade associations, and the undersigned coalitions and associations, appreciates the opportunity to provide comments on HB 2332, which concerns the disclosure of electronic communications and electronically stored data.

HB 2332 mirrors the federal Stored Communications Act (SCA) (18 U.S.C. 2701) but is missing some of the exceptions to the SCA. Our proposed amendments (attached) restore the missing sections, which include the other instances in which a person or entity may divulge the contents of an electronic communication or electronic storage. Without these exceptions, the person or entity complying with HB 2332 could be in violation of other laws. The amended sections are from the SCA, 18 U.S.C. 2702(b)(6)-(8).

Thank you for consideration of our comments. We would be happy to discuss the bill further, at your convenience.
