

House Committee on Local Government:

The City of McLouth would like to see HB2404 pass. Last year we were forced to demolish a very old "nursing home" that was, at one time, a hotel. The hotel was said to have been used by some very important people form history. The reason that we needed to demolish it was due to the long process of obtaining control of the property.

The owner was elderly and then passed. Her roommate kept he bills paid but was unable to do any keep up either. Years later he too passed. The residence housed some very valuable articles that were left by wonderful people.
