I enjoy hunting and fishing when I get the opportunity. Those opportunities are fewer today because much of the hunting locations are leased by outfitters and guides. I do not oppose guided hunts, however, in recent years those guided hunts are taking place on public lands.
I requested Wildlife and Parks to ban guide hunting on public lands. They have initiated a ban, but all the guide needs to do is state that he is a private hunter.
Being on a list as a guide or outfitter will provide the enforcement person the data to protect public lands from illegal guided hunts.
I support Senate Bill 301 as it will protect public lands from overhunting and provide private individuals more access to hunting.
