Subject: Bill Brief for HB 2454, as amended by House Committee

HB 2454 addresses detention review hearings and dispositional hearings under the Kansas juvenile justice code.

The bill as proposed would have amended K.S.A. 38-2343 to change the requirements for the 14-day detention review hearings for juveniles to allow a juvenile to waive that hearing in consultation with the juvenile's attorney. The House Committee amendments struck that proposed change. Section 1 of the bill as amended would change K.S.A. 38-2343 to provide that the 14-day detention review hearings are not required for a juvenile offender held in detention awaiting disposition pursuant to K.S.A. 38-2360(f). Section 2 would add a new subsection (f) to K.S.A. 38-2360 to require a dispositional hearing to sentence a juvenile offender being held in detention within 45 days after the juvenile has been adjudicated.
