SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2423 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2423 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2423 would prohibit providers of information services from collecting, storing, or selling the personal information of a Kansas resident who uses the services without the express written authorization of the person affected. The bill would also prohibit any provider of such services from refusing to provide services to a Kansas resident based on the resident's refusal to approve collection, storage or sale of the person's information.

According to the Kansas Corporation Commission, there would be no fiscal effect from enactment of HB 2423. No state agency regulates the Internet or Internet providers as they are considered to be jurisdictionally interstate and therefore, under the purview of the Federal Communications Commission.
