SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2460 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2460 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2460 would be required to establish curriculum guidelines for a standardized firearm safety education program. The bill states that the purpose of a district providing a firearm safety education program would be for promoting the safety and protection of students and emphasizing how students should respond when encountering a firearm.

According to the Department of Education, enactment of HB 2460 would require additional expenditures totaling \$2,500, all from the State General Fund, for travel and per diem expenditures for its staff for meeting with school administrators for input on curriculum guidelines. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2460 is not reflected in *The FY 2019 Governor's Budget Report*.
