SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 49 by Senator Faust-Goudeau

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 49 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 49 would amend existing law concerning voter registration to allow voters to register up to the day of primary and general elections. In addition, the bill establishes the requirements for persons who are not yet registered to register and vote on Election Day at a precinct voting site or a satellite advance voting site.

In order to fulfill the requirements of the bill, the Kansas Association of Counties indicates that there would be increased costs for the counties for additional personnel required to register voters at precinct and satellite advance voting sites, as well as training and computers for that personnel. Costs would vary from county to county and would be incurred for each election. The Association is unable to estimate what those costs might amount to.
