1 AN ACT regulating traffic; concerning escort vehicles, annual registration.

3 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

4 Section 1. (a) Beginning January 1, 2018, each company that operates
5 an escort vehicle service in this state shall register annually with the
6 secretary of transportation in accordance with rules and regulations
7 adopted by the secretary. The secretary shall charge and collect a fee of
8 \$50 with each annual registration.

9 (b) (1) Each application for registration shall be accompanied by the
10 following:

11 (A) The name and address of the agent for service of process. The
12 agent shall reside and shall be domiciled in this state;

13 (B) proof that each vehicle operated in this state by the applicant
14 maintains the required insurance, self-insurance or other financial security
15 required pursuant to K.S.A. 40-3104, and amendments thereto;

16 (C) proof that each driver of an escort vehicle has a valid operator's
17 license issued by a state or territory of the United States; and

18 (D) such other information as the secretary may require.

19 (2) The secretary may revoke, suspend or refuse to issue a
20 registration for any violation of this subsection.

21 (c) Any person found operating an escort vehicle in violation of this
22 section shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined \$100.

23 (d) All fees collected pursuant to this section shall be remitted to the
24 state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and
25 amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state
26 treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit
27 of the state highway fund.

28 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
29 publication in the statute book.
