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## **SENATE BILL No. 275**

AN ACT concerning<u>the</u> credit unions; relating to expulsion of
members; credit union council; <u>relating to</u> terms of service; two-term
limit; amending K.S.A. 17-2219 and 17-2232 and repealing the
existing<u>section</u> sections.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 17-2219 is hereby amended to read as follows: 17-2219. (a) Any member may be expelled from the credit union:

9 (1) By a  $^{2}/_{3}$  vote of the members present at any regularly called 10 meeting of the membership; or

11 (2) in accordance with the provisions of subsection (b), by the 12 board of directors president, general manager or any other credit union 13 employee designated by the board of directors for a member's abuse of member account privileges, a member's act or failure to act which 14 causes financial loss to the credit union,-or a member's failure to 15 purchase shares and utilize loan or other services of the credit union, 16 or a member's failure to comply with the credit union's adopted policy 17 18 regarding expulsion. The board of directors president or general manager 19 shall report the expulsion of a member at the next regularly scheduled 20 members' board meeting.

21 (b) The board of directors of a credit union may adopt a policy 22 with respect to expulsion from membership for any reason set forth in 23 paragraph (2) of subsection (a)(2). If such a policy is adopted, written notice of the policy as adopted and effective date of such policy shall 24 25 be mailed to each member of the credit union at the member's current 26 address appearing on the records of the credit union not less than 30 27 days prior to the effective date of such policy. In addition, each new 28 member shall be provided written notice of any such policy prior to or 29 upon applying for membership. The board of directors of a credit union 30 shall provide the member with a notice of expulsion from the membership 31 not less than 30 days prior to the effective date of the expulsion. Within the 32 thirty-day period, the member, by written request, may require the board of directors to bring the member's expulsion before the credit union-33 membership at the next regularly scheduled members' meeting. If the-34 member makes such written request, the board of directors' expulsion of 35 such member shall be delayed until the credit union membership votes on 36

1 such member's expulsion as provided under subsection (a) An expelled

member shall be informed of the reason for expulsion and may appeal the 2 3 expulsion to the board of directors by making a written request to the board of directors within 30 days of the expulsion. 4

(c) A member may withdraw from a credit union, as hereinafter 5 6 provided, by filing a written notice of such intention. All amounts paid 7 on shares of an expelled or withdrawing member, with any dividends 8 credited to the member's shares to the date of expulsion, or 9 withdrawal, shall be paid to the member, but only as funds become 10 available and after deducting any amounts due to the credit union by the member. All shares of an expelled or withdrawing member, with 11 12 any interest accrued, shall be paid to the member, subject to 60 days' 13 notice, and after deducting any amounts due to the credit union by the member. The member, when withdrawing shares, shall have no 14 15 further right in the credit union or to any of its benefits, but such 16 expulsion or withdrawal shall not operate to relieve such member 17 from any remaining liability to the credit union.

Section 1. Sec. 2. K.S.A. 17-2232 is hereby amended to read as 18 19 follows: 17-2232. (a) The governor shall appoint a seven-member credit 20 union council. Each member shall be a resident of Kansas. Except as 21 provided by subsection (b), appointments to the council shall be for terms 22 of three years. Five of the persons appointed shall be members in good 23 standing and officers of Kansas state chartered credit unions. Subject to the 24 provisions of K.S.A.-1995 Supp. 75-4315c, and amendments thereto, of 25 those five members, the governor shall appoint one from each congressional district and the remainder from the state at large. The 26 27 council shall elect annually a chairperson, a vice-chairperson and a 28 secretary for a term of one year or until their successors have been 29 appointed and qualified. All members of the council shall serve until their 30 successors have been appointed and qualified. Kansas state chartered 31 credit unions regulated under the provisions of this act may submit 32 annually to the governor, for consideration in making appointments to the 33 credit union council, a list of persons having the prescribed qualifications 34 for membership on the council. The council may adopt such rules and 35 regulations governing the compilation of such list as may be necessary. 36 Vacancies on the council shall be filled for the unexpired term by-37 appointment by the governor In the event of a vacancy on the council, the 38 governor shall appoint a new member to fill the unexpired term. The mid-39 term appointment of a new council member to serve an unexpired term created by such a vacancy shall not be considered a full term for purposes 40 41 of the two-term limit. Except as otherwise provided, no person shall serve more than two consecutive full three-year terms as a member of the 42

43 council. No more than four members of the council shall be from the same 1 political party.

2 (b) The terms of members who are serving on the council on the 3 effective date of this act shall expire on March 15, of the year in which 4 such member's term would have expired under the provisions of this 5 section prior to amendment by this act. Thereafter Members shall be 6 appointed for terms of three years and *serve* until their successors are 7 appointed and qualified.

8 (c) Council meetings shall be on call of a majority of the council or the chairperson. The council shall hold one regular meeting during each 9 quarter of the year, upon such dates and at such places as designated by the 10 council, and may hold such other meetings as the council considers 11 12 necessary. The majority of the council shall constitute a quorum for doing business. The council may adopt such rules as advisable for conducting 13 business and, until otherwise changed or modified, the council shall abide 14 15 by Robert's rules of order in conducting business.

16 (d) The council shall serve as an advisor to the administrator on 17 issues and needs of credit unions.

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Sec. <u>2</u>. **3.** K.S.A. **17-2219 and** 17-2232 <u>is</u> are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
publication in the<u>statute book</u> Kansas register.
