1 AN ACT concerning state officers and employees; restricting outside
2 employment.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) No state officer or employee shall be employed in any
6 capacity or receive any compensation for any work that involves more
7 than 10 hours per week performed by the state officer or employee, other
8 than the state officer's or employee's official duties.

9 (b) For the purposes of this section, the term "state officer or
10 employee" includes the following:

- 11 (1) The governor;
- 12 (2) the attorney general;
- 13 (3) the secretary of state;
- 14 (4) the commissioner of insurance;
- 15 (5) the state treasurer;
- 16 (6) each person appointed to the governor's cabinet;
- 17 (7) the public information officer and the chief attorney appointed for
18 the:

- 19 (A) Department of administration;
- 20 (B) department for aging and disability services;
- 21 (C) department of agriculture;
- 22 (D) department of commerce;
- 23 (E) department of corrections;
- 24 (F) department of health and environment;
- 25 (G) department for children and families;
- 26 (H) department of transportation; and
- 27 (I) Kansas department of wildlife, parks and tourism;
- 28 (8) the personal secretary and one special assistant to the:
29 (A) Secretary of administration;
- 30 (B) secretary for aging and disability services;
- 31 (C) secretary of agriculture;
- 32 (D) secretary of commerce;
- 33 (E) secretary of corrections;
- 34 (F) secretary of health and environment;
- 35 (G) secretary for children and families;
- 36 (H) secretary of transportation; and

1 (l) secretary of wildlife, parks and tourism.

2 (c) Any person who violates this act shall be deemed to be guilty of a
3 class A misdemeanor.

4 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
5 publication in the statute book.
