SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 216

As Amended by Senate Committee on Judiciary

Brief*

SB 216 would amend several statutes in accordance with 2012 Executive Reorganization Order (ERO) 41, which, among other changes, changed the name of the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services to the Department for Children and Families and the Department of Aging to the Department for Aging and Disability Services (KDADS) and reassigned certain powers, duties, and functions of the two agencies. The bill would amend 13 statutes to update the names of the agencies and to reflect changes made to their respective powers, duties, and functions. The bill would also make other grammatical and formatting changes, all of which are technical in nature.

Background

In the Senate Committee hearing, an assistant revisor provided information about the ERO and indicated KDADS requested to be added to two statutes included in the bill based on its current responsibilities. No proponent, opponent, or neutral testimony was provided.

The Senate Committee adopted the amendments requested by KDADS.

According to the fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget, the bill would have no fiscal effect.
