## **2018 Kansas Statutes**

**2-129c.** Tax levies for fair purposes in certain counties; use of proceeds. The board of county commissioners of any county, to which the provisions of K.S.A. 2-129 apply, having a population of more than eight thousand eight hundred (8,800) and less than nine thousand six hundred (9,600) and having an assessed taxable valuation of more than thirty million dollars (330,000,000) may make an annual tax levy upon all of the assessed taxable tangible valuation of such county for fair purposes and to pay a portion of the principal and interest on bonds issued under the authority of K.S.A. 12-1774, and amendments thereto, by cities located in the county but such tax shall not exceed a rate of one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) mill.

This act is supplemental to the provisions of K.S.A. 2-129.
