72-2647. Invalidity of part. If any section or part of a section of this act shall be held unconstitutional by any court, it shall be conclusively presumed that the legislature would have passed this act without such invalid section or part of a section, and the remaining provisions shall be given full force as if the part held unconstitutional had not been included herein.
