2018 Kansas Statutes

74-32,234. Awarding state scholarships; limitation; determination of equivalent of semesters. A state scholarship may be awarded to any qualified state scholar enrolled at any eligible institution. A state scholar may be awarded a state scholarship for not more than eight semesters of undergraduate study or the equivalent thereof, except that a state scholar may be awarded a state scholarship for not more than eight semesters of the educational program in which the state scholar is enrolled include the completion of a fifth year of study. The board of regents shall determine the equivalent of a semester when any program period or all or part of the terms for which a state scholar is awarded a state scholarship are not semesters.
