Chairman Jennings.

On Feb 20^{th,} Representative Carmichael requested information about a fiscal note regarding HB 2695, which would KDOC special agents to attend the Kansas Law Enforcement Training Center (KLETC). The fiscal note states that KLETC would receive \$9,119 in revenue from KDOC to train two officers in FY 2021. KLETC receives a portion of docket fees (KSA 12-4117) and a portion of vehicle registrations fees (KSA 8-145) to support training of law enforcement officers. However, the agency has stated that it does charge a tuition fees of some agencies. KSA 74-5609A authorizes KLETC to charge tuition for entities such as railroad policeman, tribal law enforcement agencies, and campus police. KLETC interprets this to include agents of KDOC.
