Dear Chair Landwehr and members of the Health and Human Services Committee:

Thank you for allowing us to speak to you today in support of HB 2295 which will authorize and license a new health care provider in Kansas to assist physician anesthesiologist. The provider would be known as a Certified Anesthesiologist Assistants (CAAs).

I am a physician anesthesiologist practicing in Kansas City, Kansas and a past-President of the Kansas Society of Anesthesiologists (KSA). As a native Kansan, I have been a physician anesthesiologist for 10 years and help teach the next generation of doctors for our state.

To briefly summarize events since we were last before the Committee, KSA and the Kansas Medical Society (KMS) introduced CAA licensure legislation during the 2017 legislative session. At that time, concerns were raised that the KDHE Credentialing of Health Care Personnel process had not been completed. As a result, Chairman Dan Hawkins instructed us to complete the KDHE credentialing process, and also requested KSA to meet with the Kansas Association of Nurse Anesthetists (KANA) and attempt to reach a compromise on the issue. A meeting was subsequently held where both sides had the opportunity to discuss their respective positions. After that meeting, it was reported to us that the KANA board voted to suspend any further discussions with KSA related to CAA licensure.

KSA along with representatives of the CAA community filed an application with KDHE to begin the credentialing process, and that process was recently completed. The KDHE Technical Review Committee, after a series of meetings which included the opportunity to hear from both proponents and opponents of the issue, determined that all nine criteria for provider credentialing had been met, and voted to approve the application for credentialing of CAAs in Kansas. The Technical Review Committee has recommended on their report to the KDHS secretary the CAAs credentialing application be approved and the provider be licensed by the state. That report has been forwarded to the KDHE Secretary for signature. Thus, we have completed the steps requested by the Committee and are now reintroducing legislation to license CAAs in Kansas.

During proponent testimony today you will hear from multiple physician anesthesiologists with significant, long-term experience practicing with CAAs in an anesthesia care team model. They are familiar with the education, training, and quality, safe care CAA's provide. You will also hear from multiple physician anesthesiologists in Kansas whose practices are experiencing severe provider shortages and are desperately seeking an additional provider pool to fill those needs and continue to provide access to safe anesthesia care for their patients. Lastly, you will hear from CAAs from Kansas who would like the opportunity to live and practice in their home state and contribute to the Kansas economy.

On behalf of the Kansas Society of Anesthesiologists, we respectfully request your passage of legislation to allow licensure of CAAs in Kansas and improve access to care for Kansas citizens.
