Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

New Section 1. (a) The on-farm retail sale of milk or milk products shall be lawful, so long as each container of ungraded raw milk sold or offered for sale contains a label that clearly states the following: "This product contains ungraded raw milk that is not pasteurized and, as a result, may contain organisms that cause food-borne illness, especially in infants, young children, older adults, pregnant women and people with weak immune systems." This statement shall be in letters of a uniform size and no smaller than the largest font used elsewhere on the label.

(b) Any person who engages in the on-farm retail sale of milk or milk products may advertise such milk or milk-products if such advertisement clearly states the following: "This product contains ungraded raw milk that is not pasteurized and, as a result, may contain organisms that cause foodborne illness, especially in infants, young children, older adults, pregnant women and people with weak immune systems." If such advertisement is in print or other written or visual form, this statement shall be in letters of a uniform size and no smaller than the largest font used elsewhere in the advertisement.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 65-771 is hereby amended to read as follows: 65-771. As used in this act:

- (a) "Adulterated" has the same meaning means the same as provided in K.S.A. 65-664, and amendments thereto.
- (b) "Bulk milk pick up tanker" means a vehicle including the truck, tank and those appurtenances necessary for such vehicle's use, used by a bulk milk hauler or sampler to transport bulk raw milk for pasteurization from a dairy farm to a milk plant, receiving station or transfer station.
- (c) "Dairy manufacturing plants" means any place where dairy products, grade A milk or milk products are manufactured or prepared for sale or distribution, either at wholesale or retail.—This term shall "Dairy manufacturing plants" does not include a licensed food service establishment—which that is licensed to manufacture homemade ice cream
